 - Outdoor Learning/Yarning Space& Native Garden
 - Craig informed of location and overview including native bees and plants. Last year's Woolworth's Land Care
 grant money to be spent by end of March this year.
 - Sustainable Schools Grant from Randwick City Council coming up in March which provides matched funding up to \$5,000
 - Bunning's donation items in storage
 - Does anyone know a landscape architect to help with overall design?
 - Discussion on 2022 Community Building Events
 - Colour Run

 - Perhaps see what other schools with Support Units with moderately disabled children do. The NSW DOE has a list
 of schools with Support Units



Financial/ Membership

February Report

As I stated last year, I hope this coming year we will bring more. More initiatives, more community building events, more involvement in school events, continued opportunities for student voice, consistent communication, and engagement with the whole school community.

In the past 12 months we have achieved a lot and I would like to see that continue this year. In our second year of rebuilding, I would like to see a drive to increase membership and active participation in helping the P&C deliver for our school community. Whilst we always have ample volunteers for events and fundraising we have limited P&C members and executives to help with this like planning & organisation, grant applications and general admin. This didn't hold us back last year, but if we wish to deliver more, we need to increase our bandwidth as well as consider succession planning. We won't be here for ever and there is only such much the current 4 executives can do.

Currently we have 7 vacant executive positions which includes a second vice president and 6 additional non officer holder executive roles. Additionally, we are looking for someone to become the class parent coordinator and someone to help coordinate the second-hand unforms sales throughout the year. If you interested having a positive impact on the students and school community and helping get stuff done please reach out to me or one of the other executives. We would really love your help.

We have a strong pipeline of work already this year with the school mural to be completed hopefully this term, further grant funds to spend on the Outdoor Classroom and another grant to apply for shortly.

Already this year you may have also seen the news about French language classes forming. This is a result of the languages survey we ran last year and the help of one of our lovely year 1 parents Moneera. Details for French lessons along with the all the other extracurricular activities available to students at Rainbow Street are available on the P&C website. They were also included in last weeks P&C Rambler updated in addition to the P&C newsletter (subscribe now)

We have also sent out our class parent survey which was so successful last year in getting parent lists formed accurately and early. We will be sending further reminders this week to complete the survey. Finally we also had a first second hand uniform sale which sold out again.


February 2022 P&C Meeting

Recent Activities

- Welcome to all new families. Over 100 new students commenced school at Rainbow Street last week. We are currently holding 19 mainstream and 4 Support Unit classes (two additional mainstream classes).
- Well done to the teachers and Administrative staff who have settled students into their classes and learning environments so quickly. Staff (Executive and teaching) have been asked to focus the first two weeks of the year building relationships and setting up structures, routines and expectations. It is vital teachers get to know the cohort of students in their learning space and students get to know their teachers along with the uses and expectations for each of the learning environments. Critical information has been handed over by the 2021 teachers for all students with additional needs. This ties into every student being known, valued and cared for.

• Staffing:

- We welcome back Mrs Christie McBeth, Ms Emma Hunt and Mrs Rebecca Ross who are returning from leave.
- This year we welcome some new staff to Rainbow Street Public School. Miss Anastasiya Lagutenkova (permanent classroom teacher), Ms Kate Taylor (permanent School Counsellor), Ms Stephanie Coote, Miss Cody Mctaggart, Mrs Emma Tregoning, Miss Marisa Zids, Miss Rachel Cowan, Mr Ben Carter and Mr Kilian David (temporary classroom teachers), all join our school community.
- We are also currently awaiting an appointment to a vacant classroom teacher position as we have an additional two mainstream classes this year.
- Staff are still in the process of planning arrangements for Parent Information Evening/Meet The Teachers and we will let you know our plans shortly. The sessions, once scheduled, will provide an opportunity to meet the teachers who will be teaching your child in the learning hub and general information about teaching and learning programs, structures and routines, and events.
- Best Start Assessment of students in Kindergarten commenced last week. Data collected provides teachers with information as to where each student is at in literacy and numeracy and informs 'where to next' so that appropriate teaching and learning experiences can be planned. Reports are issued to parents later in the term.
- 2nd hand Uniform Sale Another successful sale! Thank you to all families who donated items and parents who 'manned' the stall.
- New COVID-smart measures were implemented for the return to school, specifically surveillance using rapid antigen testing. Thank you to everyone who tested students prior to school. Additional tests will be provided to families this week for testing in Week 4 and 5.



- Sport:
 - The school swimming carnival will be held at Des Renford Aquatic Centre next Monday, 14 February 2022. To minimize mixing of cohorts, only competitors will attend this year's carnival. All races are 50m and students entering must be able to swim 50m unaided using correct technique. Parents are most welcome however will not be able to sit in the grandstand with students or be on the pool deck.
 - The Eastern Suburbs PSSA will be meeting on Wednesday to discuss sport in our Zone. At this stage PSSA will be running this term but will commence slightly later than usual (given we are already in Week 3).
 - ESPSSA representative team trials commence this week. These representative team trials are advertised in the Rambler and announced to students. Students interested in trialing should see Mr Richmond.
 - House Captain elections will be held this week.
- Staff Professional Learning Focus:
 - School Development Day School information, organisational tasks, professional learning and a lot of collaborative teaching and learning planning
 - Staff are working through their mandated annual training such as Child Protection Mandatory Training 2022 and Code Of Conduct.
 - Compass (all teaching and admin staff)
- Community Users Discussions are currently underway to ensure COVID-safe plans and operations are in place for community users.
- SRE and SEE Plans for recommencement are underway. Mrs Counsel is reviewing rooms etc. to avoid cohort mixing. It is anticipated that these programs will recommence in Week 4 provided plans are in place and providers have met the vaccination requirements and have teachers available.
