August 2021 P&C Meeting

Recent Events

- Some events were able to be completed before lockdown commenced:
 - Disco – thank you to all involved.
 - Athletics Carnival (with the exception of the 1500m)
- Level 4 COVID restrictions are in place currently:
 - Learning from home.
 - Working from home.
 - Masks on site, social distancing and QR code check-in.
 - Only essential visitors to site.
- Events:
 - Due to COVID a number of events have been cancelled: ESPSSA weekly sport and trials, SEPSSA events, trials and carnivals, Stage 2 and Stage 3 overnight excursions, Premier's Debating Challenge and The Festival Of Instrumental Music.
 - Art Show – Will be deferred as students have not been onsite to make artworks.
 - School Photos moved to Term 4.
 - Opportunity Class Placement Test, VALID Year 6 Science Assessment, NAPLAN Online Readiness and Year 1 Phonics Assessments have been deferred.
- Staff Professional Learning:
 - School Development Day – Assessment (all teaching staff)
 - Administrative staff (Office and SLSOs) have been completing numerous courses linked to their duties and individual Performance and Development Plan when working from home
 - CPR online component (all staff)
 - Teaching staff have continued to undertake PL to support their Performance and Development Plan
 - Phonological Awareness (all teaching staff and SLSOs)
- Works
 - Some works such as indoor labelling, sink overflows, were able to be completed in the school holidays but remaining works are currently on hold due to the construction restrictions in place.
- Randwick Traffic Committee Meeting – Council to undertake further data collection once 'normal' traffic resumes.
- Anticipated 2022 enrolments have been submitted.
